
Practical Placements: OHS Flowchart

NOTE: This checklist should be used to conduct an initial risk assessment of all Prospective Host Employers. If an incident occurs during placement or information comes to hand that suggests a change has occurred in the OHS practices of the Host Employer, this checklist should be updated.
